

My Anchor and My Hope

- ⇒ Remember the three audiences of Hebrews and context.
- ⇒ Leave the elementary, move forward, go on to maturity. (vs. 1-3)
 - o Do not abandon to living under the law.
- ⇒ It is impossible to repent with a hardened heart. (vs. 4-6)
 - o Picture of land and rain. (vs. 7-8)
- ⇒ "Beloved...better things things that belong to salvation." (vs. 9)
- ⇒ Be earnest to have full assurance of hope. (vs. 10-12)
- ⇒ Two unchangeable things. (vs. 13-20)
 - o God's promise (vs. 15)
 - o God's oath (vs. 16)

SALVATION:

- ➤ <u>Justification</u>: the action of declaring or being made righteous in the sight of God. (Hebrews 9:22; Rom. 3:24)
- ➤ <u>Redemption:</u> the purchase of God's favor and freedom. (Hebrews 9:11-14; Gal. 3:13)
- ➤ <u>Grace:</u> the free unmerited love and favor of God. (Hebrews 4:16; Eph. 2:8-9)
- ➤ Adoption: the act of becoming a child of God. (Hebrews 12:7-8; 1 Jn. 3:1-2)
- ➤ <u>Propitiation:</u> the atoning sacrifice offered to God to satisfy His wrath. (Hebrews 9:5; Rom. 3:25)
- ➤ <u>Imputation:</u> to credit, to attribute, or to reckon the righteousness of God to our account. (Hebrews 10:22; Rom. 4:3)
- ➤ <u>Forgiveness:</u> the pardon or remission of offense. (Heb. 8:12; Col. 1:14)
- ➤ <u>Sanctification</u>: the act of making holy; a state of separation unto God. (Hebrews 2:11,10:10; 1 Cor. 1:30)
- ➤ <u>Glorification:</u> the exaltation to honor and dignity; elevation to glory. (Hebrews 12:1; Rom. 8:30)
